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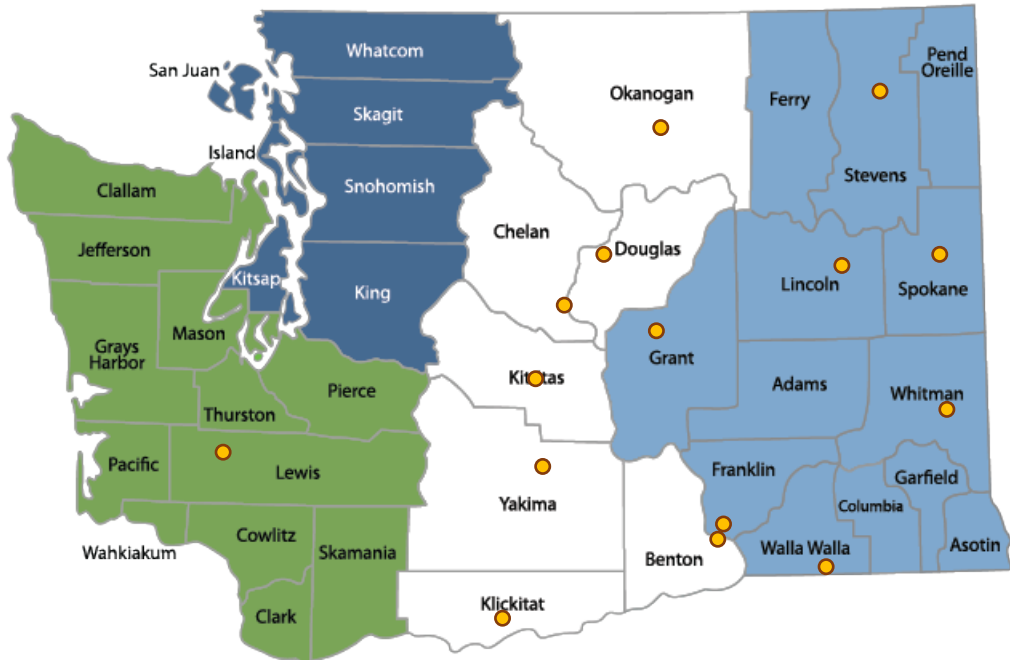

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Abstract

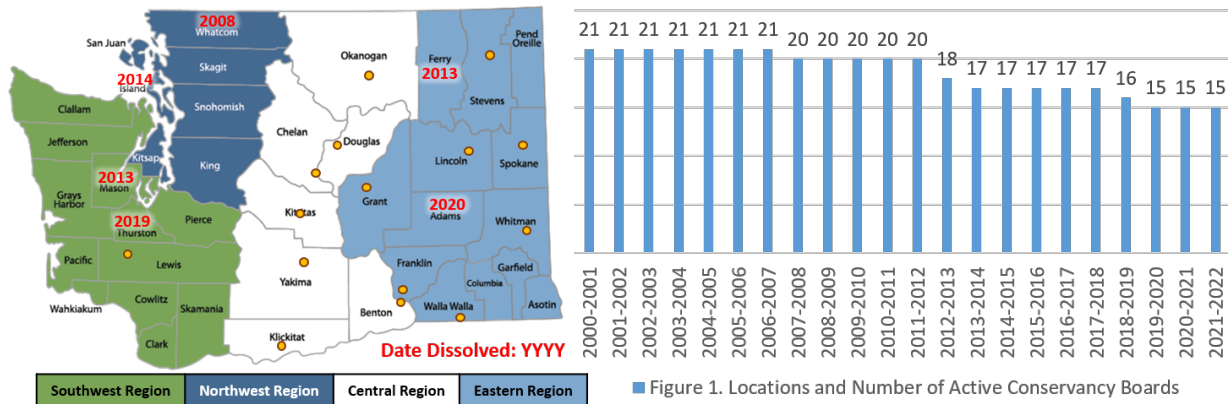
This report is an overview of the activities of 15 county Water Conservancy Boards within Washington State during the two-year period from November 1, 2020 through October 31, 2022. For a two-year tally of board actions, refer to Table 1 on page 17.

Program Background

In an effort to alleviate the backlog of water right change applications on file with the Department of Ecology (Ecology), the 1997 Legislature authorized the creation of volunteer water conservancy boards in each county that chose to form a board. The boards process water right changes and transfers (applications) only. They do not handle requests for new water rights and lack authority to process applications involving tribal lands.

There are now 15 county-initiated boards, seven in eastern Washington, seven in central Washington, and one in southwest Washington. At the peak, from 2000-2007, there were 21 boards established statewide. In 2008, Whatcom County dissolved their board. In 2013, Ferry County and Mason County dissolved their boards. In 2014, Island County dissolved their board. In 2019, Thurston County dissolved its board. In 2020, Adams County was the most recent government to dissolve their board due to inactivity. The volunteer boards perform a valuable service to Washington citizens and businesses by reducing the time between filing and receiving a decision on water right change applications. The boards provide direct assistance to the potential applicants in their jurisdictions, and enable a timelier review of viable applications. The thorough review and vetting by boards in turn saves Ecology staff resources.

Each board is a separate, independently funded unit of local government, as provided in RCW 90.80.60(2), and sets its application fee internally. The applicant pays a processing fee if the water right change application is accepted by the board and pays the cost of publishing a public notice in a local newspaper. Although board members volunteer their time, typical board expenses include travel costs for training, field exams, and general office expenses. The boards are required to submit annual expense reports to the State Auditor’s Office, and submit to audits when requested by that office.

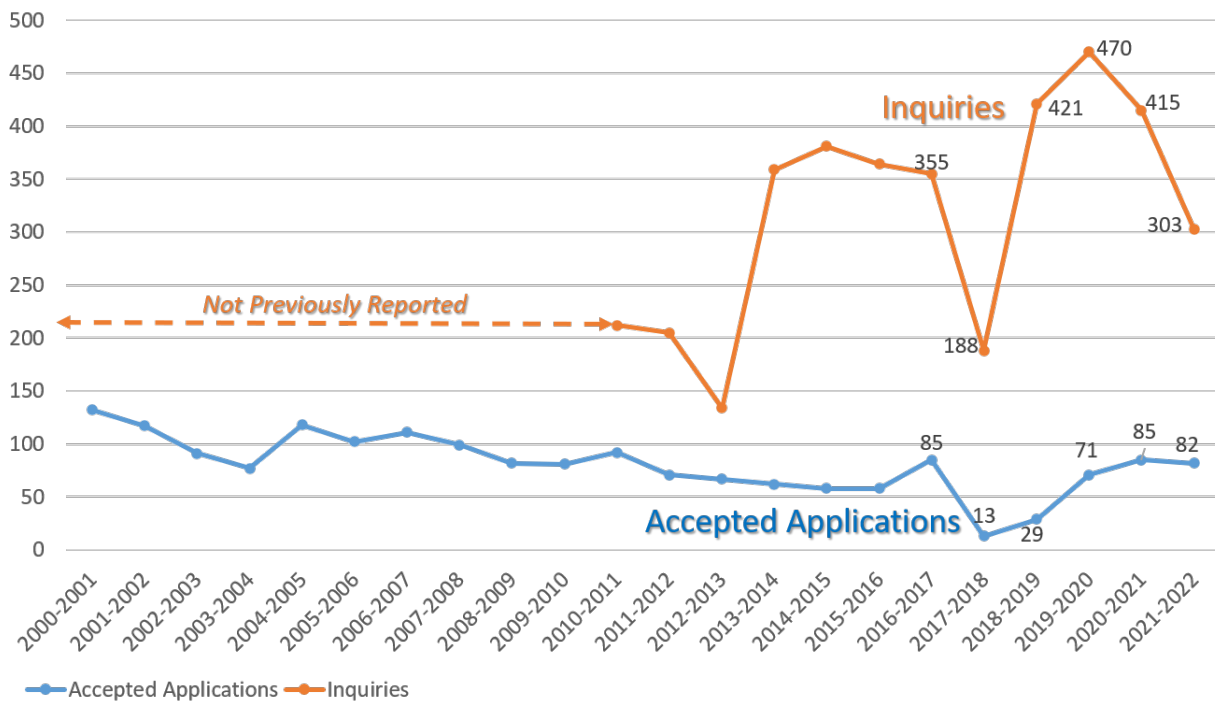
Annual reports are required to be submitted to Ecology, and are the basis of this report. See page 20 for board reports for the 2021-2022 reporting cycle.

Overview of Board Actions

Of the 15 total boards, 15 submitted annual reports for 2021 and 2022. See Table 1 on page 17 for a tabulation of board actions by Ecology region for the biennium. A comparison of those actions for the 2021-2022 reporting period verses 2019-2020 shows:

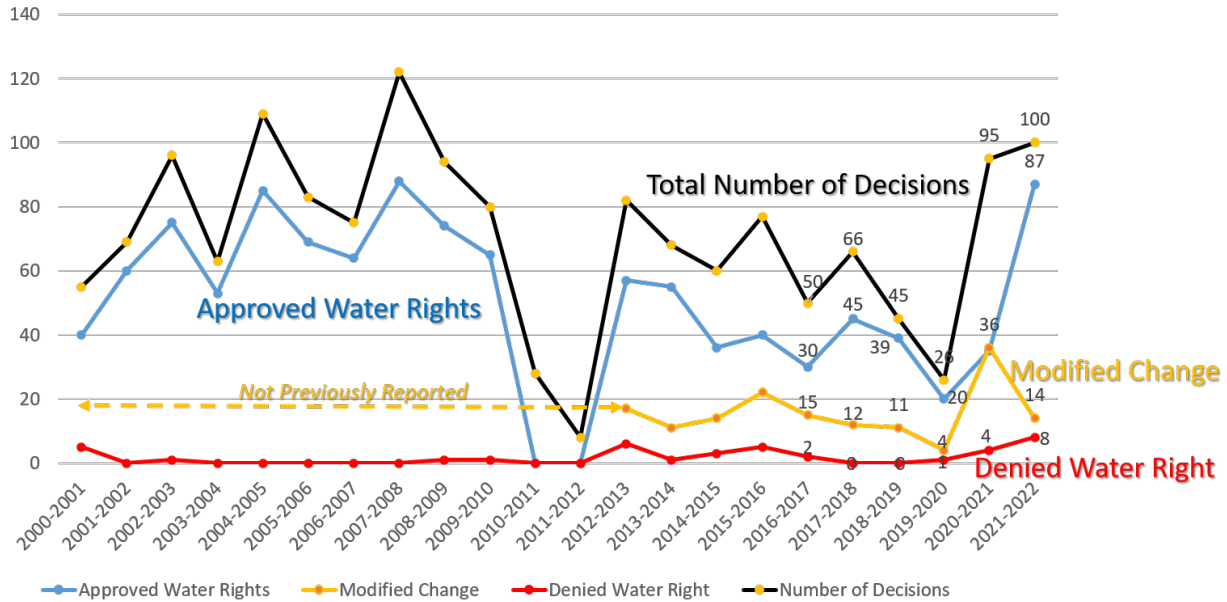
- There was an increase in accepted applications, from 100 in the previous biennium to 167. Additionally, there was a decrease in the number of board inquiries (including those with the individual board commissioners) from 891 in the previous biennium to 718. Refer to Figure 2, below.

Figure 2. Accepted Applications, Total Inquiries (with Board/Commissioners)

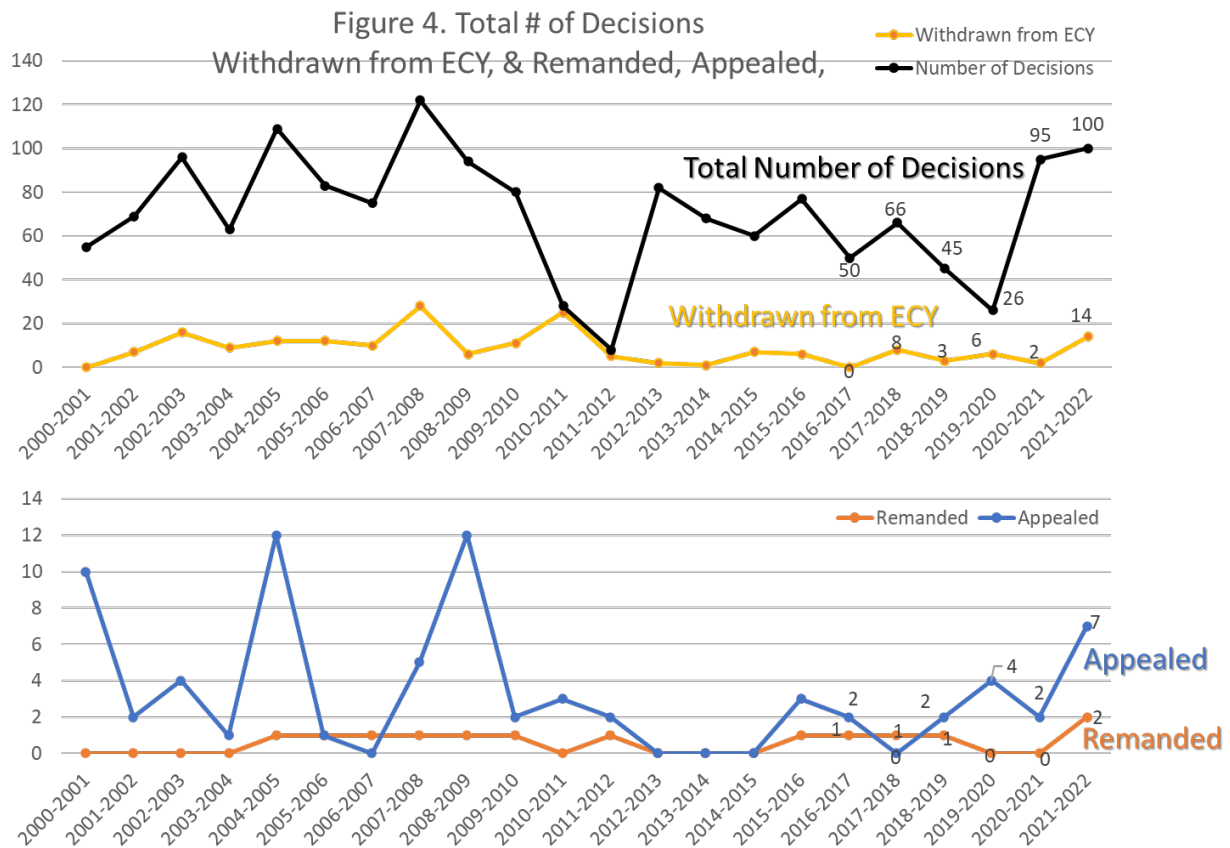


- There was an increase in approved water right decisions from 69 in the previous biennium to 123. Refer to Figure 3, below.
- There was an increase in modified change applications from 15 in the previous biennium to 50. Refer to Figure 3, below.
- The number of denied water right decisions increased from 1 in the previous biennium to 12. Refer to Figure 3, below.

Figure 3. Approved, Modified, Denied, Total # of Decisions

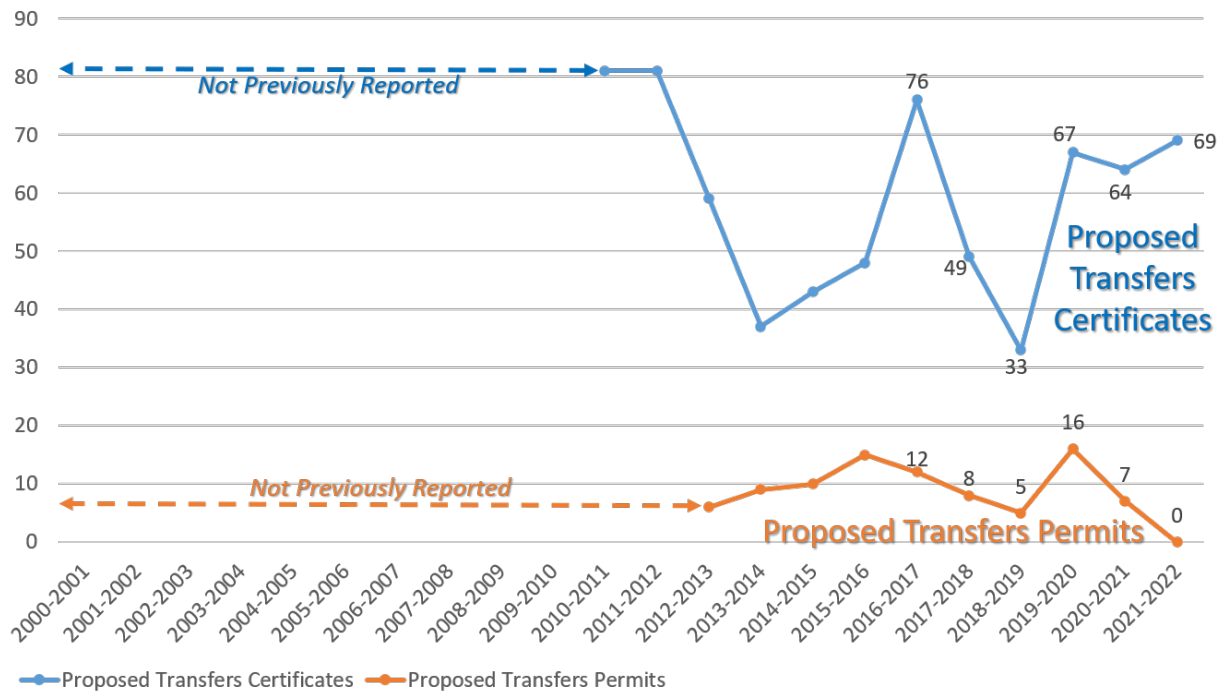


- There was an increase in the number of decisions by water conservancy boards (approved, modified, denied, withdrawn from Ecology, remanded back to board, appealed to PCHB) from 71 in the previous biennium to 195. Refer to Figure 4, below.
- There was an increase in withdrawn from Ecology from 9 in the previous biennium to 16. Refer to Figure 4, below.
- There was an increase in appealed from 6 in the previous biennium to 9. Refer to Figure 4, below.
- There was an increase in remanded from 1 in the previous biennium to 2. Refer to Figure 4, below.



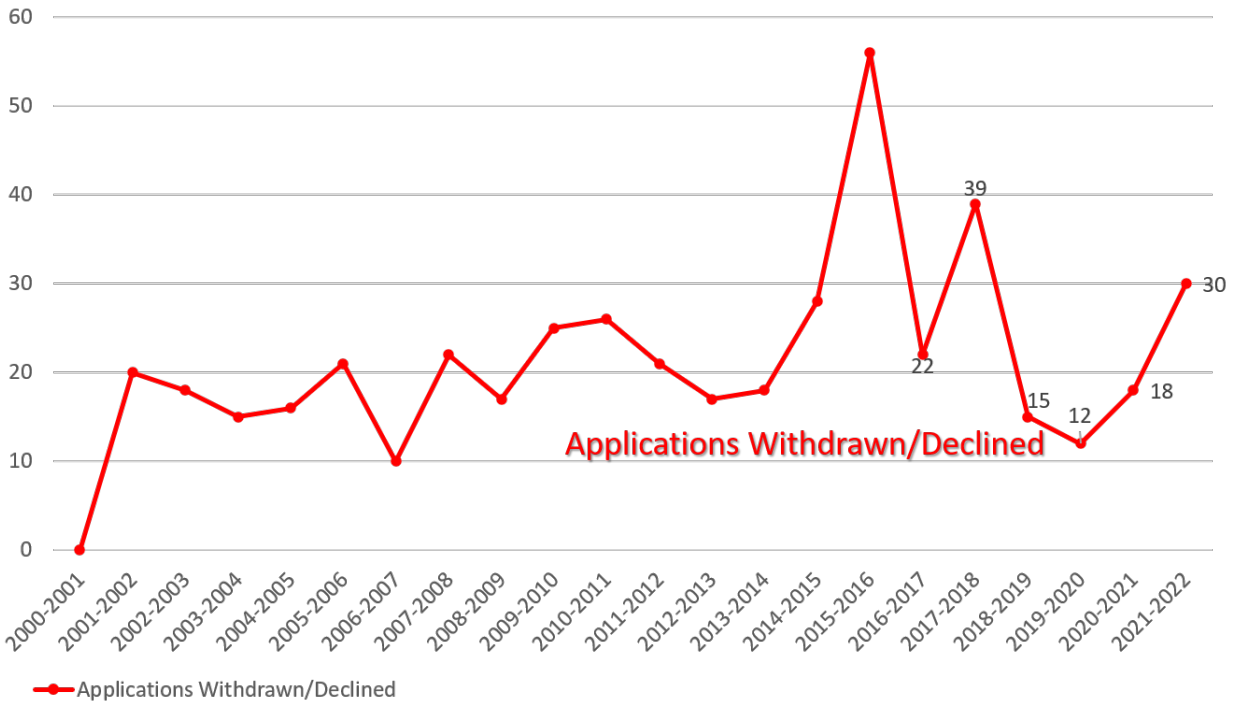
- There was an increase in proposed transfers for water right certificates from 100 in the previous biennium to 133. Refer to Figure 5, below.
- There was a decrease in proposed transfers for water rights permits from 21 in the previous biennium to 7. Refer to Figure 5, below.

Water Right Certificates, Water Right Permits



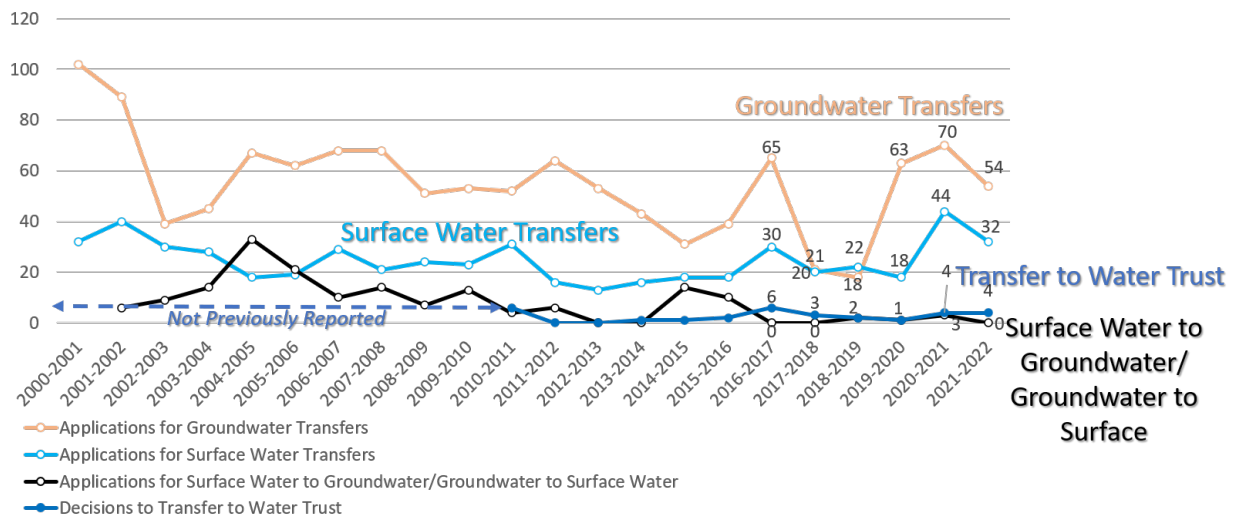
- There was an increase in the number of applications withdrawn or declined (either by the board or the applicant) from 27 in the previous biennium to 48. Refer to Figure 6, below.

- There was an increase in the total number of approvals for groundwater transfers from 81 in the previous biennium to 124. Refer to Figure 7, below.
- There was an increase in the total number of approvals for surface water transfers from 40 in the previous biennium to 76. Refer to Figure 7, below.
- The number of approvals for changes from surface to ground or ground to surface water had no change (from 3 in the previous biennium to 3). Refer to Figure 7, below.
- There was an increase in the total number of decisions to transfer to Trust Water from 3 in the previous biennium to 8. Refer to Figure 7, below.

Board Operations

Each board has many years of operating experience, and some continue to write the Report of Examination (ROE), following careful review of the water right change application. It is now more common for boards to review the ROE completed by a consultant hired by the applicant. Ecology staff is available at every stage to provide technical assistance to the boards, but do not interact with the applicant unless technical assistance is requested by the board.

All board activities are subject to the Open Public Meetings Act, RCW 42.30 and RCW 42.32, and requirements of the Public Records Act, RCW 42.56. Each eligible board member votes to approve or deny the ROE, documenting their rationale, conclusions, and the board's decision.

A board's Record of Decision (ROD) is submitted to Ecology for final review and decision. The public may submit comments during the board's review process, and up to 30 days after Ecology receives the board's final decision. The board can choose to withdraw the decision (ROD-ROE) from Ecology at any time prior to Ecology's final decision. Ecology may approve, approve with modification(s), remand or deny the ROD-ROE. The applicant and members of the public have the option to appeal Ecology's final decision to the PCHB.

Qualifications and Training

Board volunteers are appointed to a six-year term, and are required to complete an initial 32-hour training in hydrology, state water law, state water policy, administrative and judicial case law developments, field practices, evaluation of existing water rights, and practical experience working with Ecology staff on applications for water right transfers.

Ecology's Water Resources Program staff typically organizes and presents a three-day live training, and many of the continuing education events, and also encourages/approves members' efforts to obtain continuing education on their own. Ecology has created eight online training modules as a way to improve training accessibility and reduce time and travel costs that are incurred by the board members and Ecology staff.
