Let's talk about adjudication

When it is not clear who has the right to use water, adjudication reviews all water use in a local court process. Everyone needs to submit a claim that explains the water they use.

If you use water from a source other than a public water system, it's important to take part in the adjudication to secure your future right to use water.

What's next for the Nooksack

- We notify all water users by certified mail. Spring 2024
 The mailing will include instructions and a form for you to return.
- **You** fill out the form about your water use and submit it to the court in person, by mail or online within one year of receipt.
- We review the forms and let you know if we need more information.
- **We** write a report about your water use.
- **The court** considers the final report, decides on everyone's water rights, and issues a list in order of priority. If you disagree with the report, you may file an objection with the court.
