Who regulates what?




Airplanes

- EPA sets national standards for **greenhouse gas emissions** from airplanes
- The Federal Aviation Administration requires new airplanes to be **more fuel-efficient**



Automobiles

- Ecology regulates **air pollution** and **greenhouse gas emissions** from cars, trucks, and transportation fuels
- EPA sets standards for new automobiles, cutting down on **harmful emissions**



Trains

- EPA regulations limit diesel pollution from locomotives by **reducing idling** and **replacing old engines**
