Keyport Permit Renewed

Ecology (we) reissued a final dangerous waste permit for the U.S. Navy's Keyport facility in Kitsap County. The permit is effective August 30, 2024, and is valid for 10 years.

The Navy's Keyport base tests and repairs undersea warfare systems and components. It generates dangerous waste from this work. We held a public comment period from April 8 to June 14, 2024, to receive feedback on Keyport's draft dangerous waste permit and draft public participation plan. After considering and responding to the comments, we finalized Keyport's documents without further changes.

This permit allows the Navy to continue managing dangerous waste in a building specifically designed and constructed for that purpose. It replaces the permit issued in 2007 and covers the same facility, wastes, and waste operations, with an increase in outdoor storage capacity. Future changes would require a permit modification subject to public review.
