# Washington Cap-and-Invest Program 2024 Annual Auction Allowance Notice

Issued on February 02, 2024

The Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) will hold four auctions of allowances in 2024. This document, the 2024 Annual Auction Allowance Notice, specifies the Washington 2024 annual state-owned supply for the quarterly auctions in 2024. Each quarterly auction held in 2024 will offer 2024 vintage allowances. Two of the quarterly auctions will concurrently hold Advance Auctions that will offer 2027 vintage allowances.

All allowance values are subject to change and will be communicated 60 days prior to each auction.

## **Quarterly Auction Information**

Additional allowances may be auctioned, primarily based on entity consignment decisions. For final auction-specific allowance totals, an Auction Notice will be published at least 60 days prior to each auction. Each Auction Notice will provide information about the number of allowances to be offered and the auction schedule for the applicable auction.
