Do you manufacture, sell, lease, rent, or otherwise bring into Washington commerce any new product or equipment that contain HFCs?

If you answered yes, the prohibitions may apply to you!


In December 2020 and November 2023, Ecology adopted the Hydrofluorocarbons and other fluorinated gases requirements restricting the use of certain HFCs in certain products and equipment in Washington.

This applies to you if you sell, lease, rent, manufacture, or otherwise bring the following products containing HFCs into Washington commerce:

- Residential and commercial refrigeration equipment
- Residential and commercial conditioning equipment, including heat pumps
- Foams
- Aerosol products
- Small cans of refrigerant for motor vehicle and small appliance repair
- Other nonessential consumer products
