

Quarter 3, 2023 Data Summary

Clean Fuel Standard

This report is a summary of the total number of deficits and credits generated by program participants during quarter 3 of 2023 and is generated using data submitted by program participants. For this reason, there may be changes to the data as Ecology continues to work with regulated parties on corrections to their initial reporting. The aggregated quarterly data for the program is also posted in an Excel format on our [Data & Reports](#) webpage.

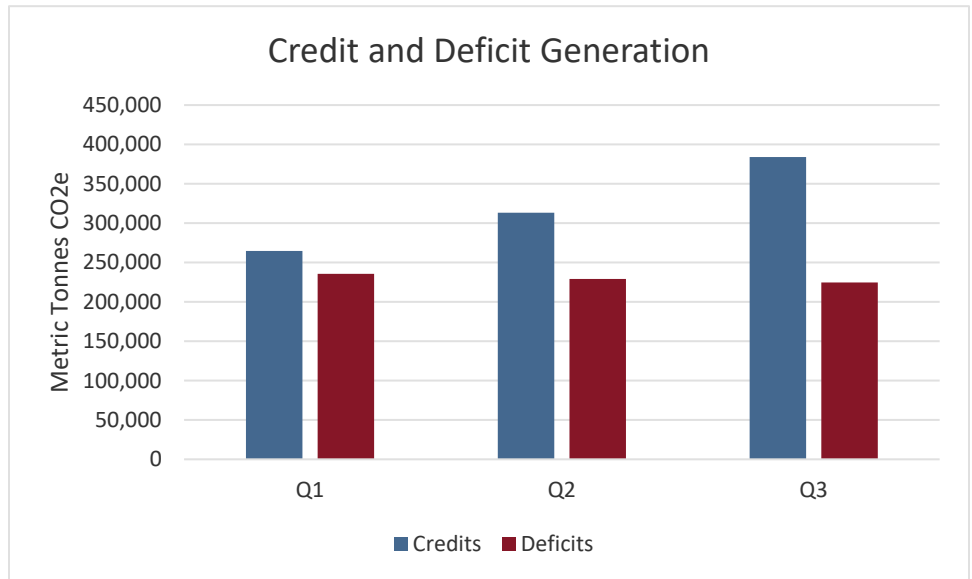


Figure 1. Total number of credit and deficits generated during Q3 and the metric tonnes of CO2 they represent.

Figure 1 shows the number of credits and deficits generated. Credits are generated by fuels whose carbon intensity falls below this year's target, while deficits are generated by fuels whose carbon intensity is higher than this year's target. 383,926 credits were generated in the third quarter versus 224,749 deficits.

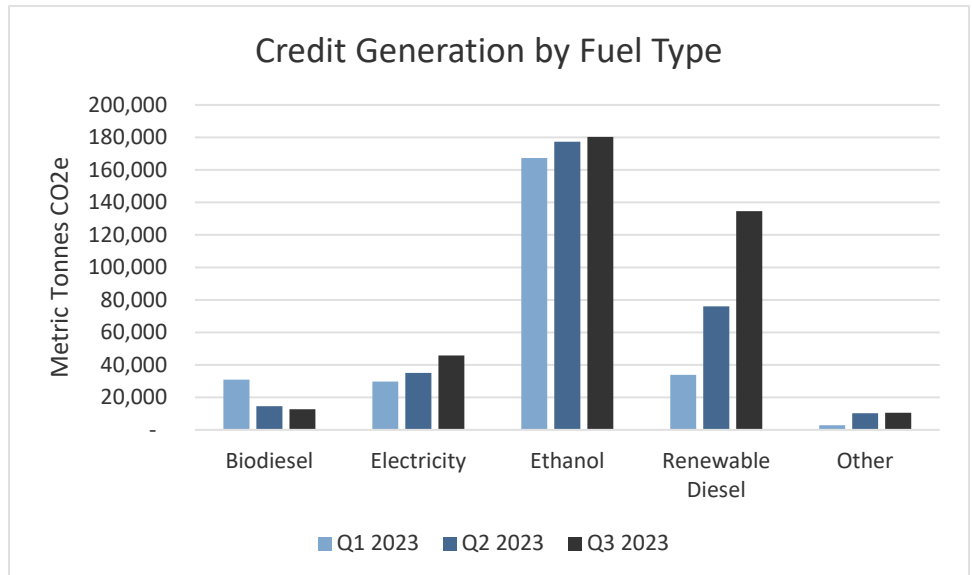


Figure 2. Fuels reported in the third quarter with a carbon intensity below the 2023 standard.

Figure 2 shows the breakdown of credit generation by fuel type during the second quarter. This data does not include residential EV charging.
