Washington Cap-and-Invest Program Auction #9 March 2025 Public Proceeds Report

Issued on April 2, 2025

Background

Ecology held an auction of allowances on March 5, 2025 (Auction #9). This auction included the sale of 2023, 2024, and 2025 current vintage allowances. No future vintage allowances were sold. Ecology approved the results of the auction and issued an <u>Auction Summary Report</u>¹ on March 12, 2025.

This Public Proceeds Report provides information regarding proceeds to the State of Washington from the sale of allowances at Auction #9. There were allowances consigned for sale at Auction #9.
