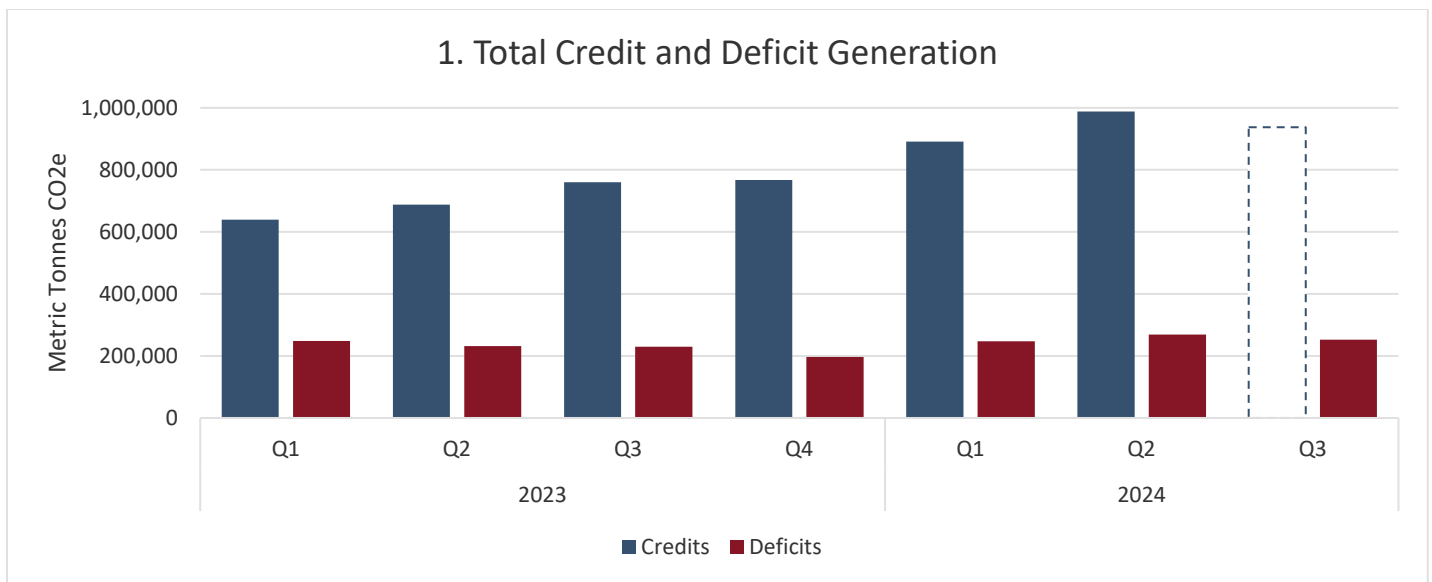


# Quarter 3, 2024 Data Summary

## Clean Fuel Standard

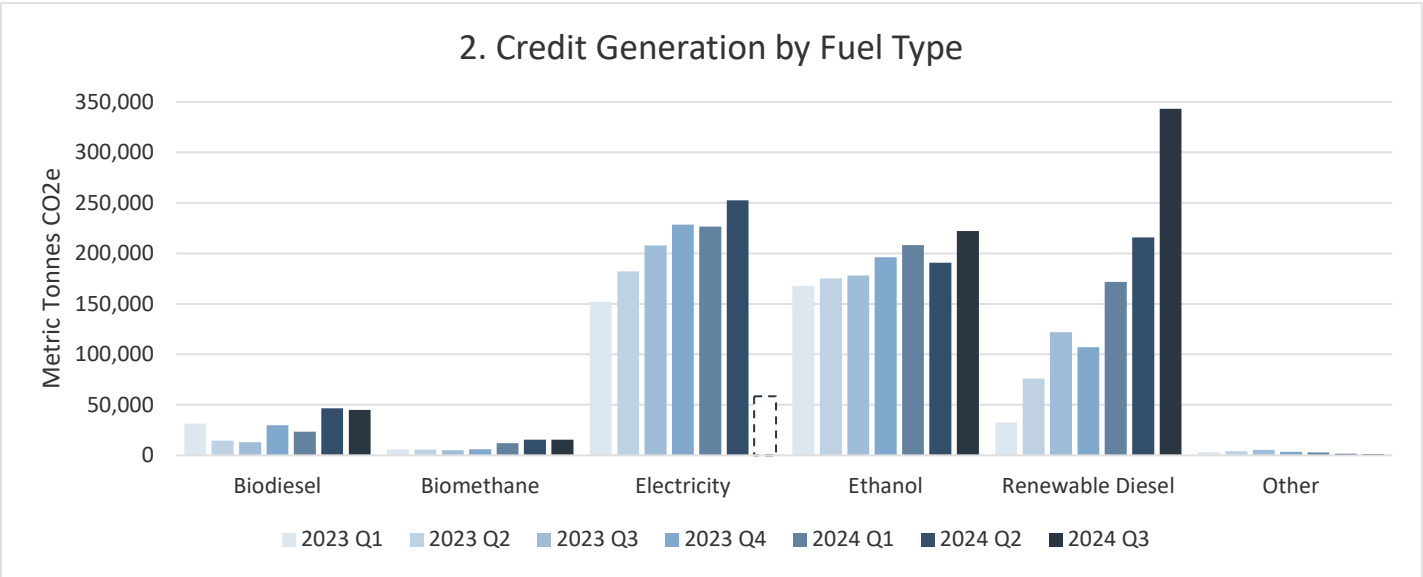
This report is a summary of the total number of deficits and credits generated by program participants during quarter 3 of 2024 and is generated using data submitted by program participants. For this reason, there may be changes to the data as Ecology continues to work with regulated parties on corrections to their reporting. The aggregated quarterly data for the program is also posted in an Excel format on our [Data & Reports](https://www.ezview.wa.gov/site/alias__1962/37916/clean_fuel_standard_data_reports.aspx)<sup>1</sup> webpage.

**Figure 1** shows the number of credits and deficits generated. Credits are generated by fuels whose carbon intensity falls below this year's target, while deficits are generated by fuels whose carbon intensity is higher than this year's target. 639,239 credits were generated in the second quarter versus 248,786 deficits. The total credits in quarter 3 of 2024 are represented with a dashed line because they do not include credits from non-metered residential EV charging. These included in a future quarterly data summary.

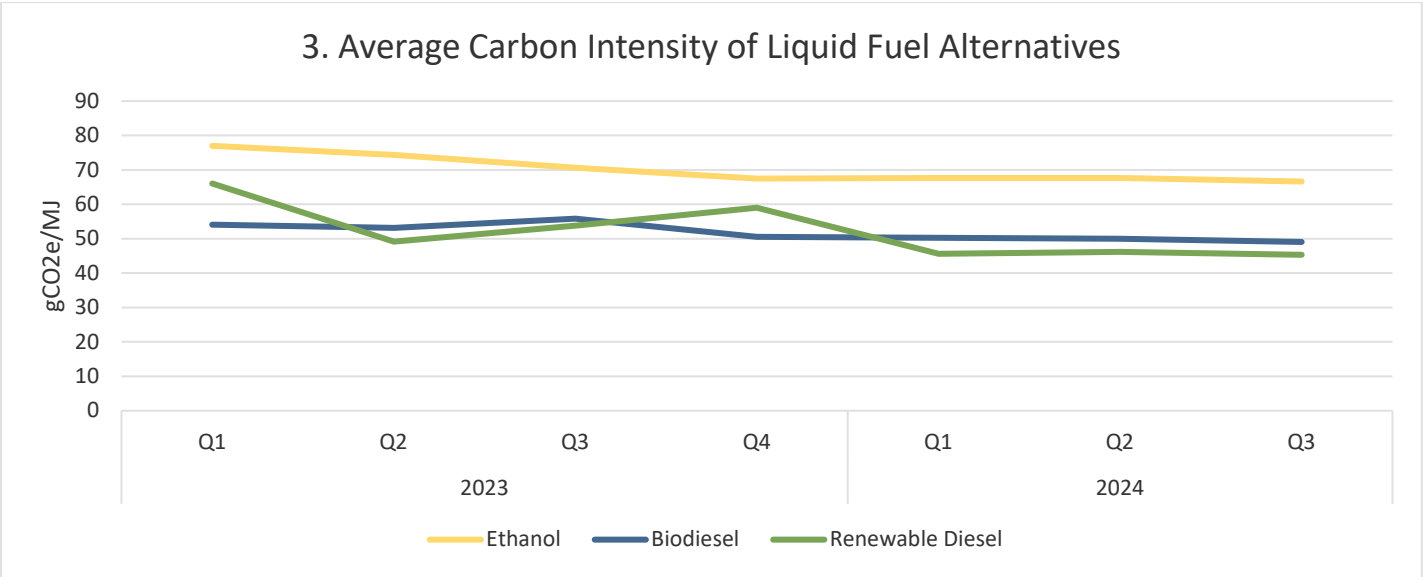

**Figure 2** shows the breakdown of credit generation by fuel type. The electricity credits in quarter 3 of 2024 are represented with dashed lines because they do not include credits from non-metered residential EV charging. These included in a future quarterly data summary.



**Figure 3** shows the volume-weighted average carbon intensity of liquid fuel alternatives reported from Q1 2023-Q3 2024. This demonstrates whether or not fuels are reducing in carbon intensity.
