Washington Cap-and-Invest Program Auction #10 June 2025 Public Proceeds Report

Issued on July 2, 2025

Background

Ecology held an auction of allowances on June 4, 2025 (Auction #10). This auction included the sale of 2024 and 2025 current vintage allowances and 2028 future vintage allowances. Ecology approved the results of the auction and issued an <u>Auction Summary Report</u> on June 11, 2025.

This Public Proceeds Report provides information regarding proceeds to the State of Washington and consigning entities from the sale of allowances at Auction #10.

The total amount of proceeds from the sale of the state-owned allowances is listed in Table 4 below. Auction proceeds are deposited into the three primary accounts and four sub-accounts to fund specific types of emissions reduction, energy efficiency, environmental justice, and ecological projects. All proceeds from the auction of allowances consigned by utilities must be used for the benefit of ratepayers, including mitigating impacts to low-income customers.
