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Washington Cap-and-Invest Program Auction # 11 September 2025 Summary Report

Issued on September 10, 2025

Background

Ecology conducted auction of allowances on September 3, 2025. The auction offered current vintage allowances from 2024 and 2025. No future vintage allowances were offered. Auction #11 included allowances consigned to auction by utilities.

Prior to today's certification of Auction #11, Ecology staff and the independent market monitor evaluated bids and determined that the auction process and procedures complied with the requirements of the Washington regulation. The Market Monitor made the following determination:

The Market Monitor found that the auction was cleared consistent with the auction clearing rules in the regulation and appropriate economic logic. The Market Monitor confirmed the clearing price and clearing quantities by qualified bidder. The auction algorithm correctly applied requirements of the regulation covering the bid guarantee. The Market Monitor did not observe any breaches of communication protocols.

The Market Monitor recommends Ecology approve the September 2025 Auction results.

Following receipt of all payments from qualified bidders, the Financial Services Administrator will distribute auction proceeds to the State of Washington and to consigning entities. On October 1, 2025, Ecology will issue the Auction Public Proceeds Report, detailing the final proceeds generated from this auction. By that date, allowances awarded to winning bidders will also be transferred.

Auction Results

All allowances offered for sale were sold. The settlement price for current vintage allowances was \$64.30 per allowance. No future vintage allowances were offered in this auction. The settlement price was above the APCR Tier 1 trigger price of \$60.43.

Winning bidders in the current auction will receive a mix of allowances from each vintage, allocated in proportion to the share of each vintage offered in the auction. For this auction, 2% of the available allowances are vintage 2024. Each whole lot (1,000 allowances) will include roughly 20 vintage 2024 allowances, and 980 vintage 2025 allowances.

^{*}Herfindahl-Hirschman Index (HHI) is a measure of market concentration and competitiveness, the values of which range from 0 to 10,000. A lower HHI value indicates a higher level of competition. A higher HHI value indicates greater market concentration among fewer entities.
