Washington Cap-and-Invest Program APCR Auction #4 October 2025 Summary Report

Issued on October 8, 2025

Background

Ecology held an auction of allowances on October 1, 2025. The auction included a sale of vintageless allowances from the Allowance Price Containment Reserve (APCR), sold at a single tier price.

Prior to today's certification of APCR #4, Ecology staff and the independent market monitor evaluated bids and determined that the auction process and procedures complied with the requirements of the Washington Regulation. The Market Monitor made the following determination:

The Market Monitor found that the October APCR auction was cleared consistent with the APCR auction clearing rules in the Regulations. Participants did not violate ECY's bid limit rule as defined in its email to participants. The Market Monitor confirmed the clearing quantities by qualified bidder. The auction algorithm correctly applied requirements of the Regulations covering the bid guarantee. The Market Monitor did not observe any breaches of communication protocols. The Market Monitor recommends that ECY approve the October APCR Auction results.

The Financial Services Administrator will distribute auction proceeds to the State of Washington. Ecology will release information on October 29, 2025, in the Auction Public Proceeds Report, providing the final amount of proceeds generated from APCR #4.

Auction Results

A total of 3,641,333 allowances were offered at auction, all at the tier 1 price. Bidders purchased 3,641,333 allowances during the auction. Only covered or opt-in entities were eligible to participate, and consignment of allowances by utilities was not permitted.

^{*}Herfindahl-Hirschman Index (HHI) is a measure of market concentration and competitiveness, the values of which range from 0 to 10,000. A lower HHI Value indicates a higher level of competition. A higher HHI value indicates a greater market concentration among fewer entities.
