Public Used Oil sites include all sites that are recognized by the local jurisdiction and available to receive used oil from the public, whether owned or operated by a public agency or private company. Oil reported here can be measured or, when necessary, estimated. Please do not report oil generated by fleet maintenance, oil change, or auto maintenance businesses except for any oil that is delivered to a public collection point at such operations.
