In the Salmon, Snow and Big Quilcene subbasins a new groundwater withdrawal for commercial agriculture relying on the water right permit exemption in RCW 90.44.050 must register with Ecology.

- Each user is limited to 5,000 gpd (maximum) as a permit-exempt well under RCW 90.44.050.
- Each user must register with ecology or its designee before water use for commercial irrigation begins.
- If the commercial agricultural use ceases, then the balance of the water returns to the reserve and use of the well shall be consistent with the conservation standard defined in WAC 173-517-120.
- A water meter is required
