V. Certification Statement

I certify under penalty of law that I have read and understand the eligibility requirements for claiming a condition of "no exposure" and obtaining an exclusion from stormwater discharge permit requirements.

I certify under penalty of law that there are no discharges of stormwater contaminated by exposure to industrial activities or materials from the industrial facility identified in this Request [except as allowed under 40 CFR §122.26 (g)(2)].

I understand that I am obligated to submit a No Exposure Exemption Request once every five years to the Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) and, if requested, to the operator of the local municipal separate storm sewer system (MS4) into which the facility discharges (where applicable). I understand that I must allow Ecology (or MS4 operator where the discharge is into the local MS4) to perform inspections to confirm the condition of no exposure and to make such inspection reports publicly available upon request. I understand that I must obtain coverage under the applicable stormwater discharge permit prior to any changes at the facility that will result in exposure of stormwater to industrial activities.

I certify under penalty of law that this Request and all attachments were prepared under my direction or supervision in accordance with a system designed to assure that qualified personnel properly gathered and evaluated the information submitted. Based upon my inquiry of the person or persons who manage the system, or those persons directly involved in gathering the information, the information submitted is to the best of my knowledge and belief true, accurate, and complete. I am aware there are significant penalties for submitting false information, including the possibility of fine and imprisonment for knowing violations.
