



Air Monitoring Site Access Agreement: Between the Washington State Department of Ecology and:

Research to characterize air pollution and its health effects is consistent with the mission of the Washington State Department of Ecology's Air Quality Program. In order to support such research efforts, Ecology can arrange to provide access to its air monitoring sites on a case-by-case basis for researchers to collect measurements collocated with Ecology monitoring equipment. Applicants seeking access to air monitoring sites should fill out page 1 of this agreement and submit the application to the primary site operator. Site access will not be permitted until a completed Air Monitoring Site Access Agreement is signed by both parties.
