Instructions for Notice of Termination Form



Water Treatment Plant General Permit, WA State Department of Ecology

Submit a Notice of Termination Form to the Department of Ecology when all discharges authorized under the permit have ended and will not be continued in future years.

- **I. Permittee Information** Provide the name, address, and contact information of the Permittee (person who is responsible for the permit coverage). This person will also be sent the final fee invoice.
- **II. Permit Information** Provide the permit type or name, permit number, site or entity name (e.g. local government), city (or nearest city), and county for the waterbody covered by the permit.
- **III. Justification for Termination** Provide a brief description why you are requesting termination. (e.g. operations have ceased, backwash wastewater will not be discharged to surface waters. Be sure to include dates of significant changes to operations).
- **IV. Certification of Permittee** Read this statement carefully. The Permittee must print his or her name for clarity, sign and date the document on the lines provided, and mail the form to Ecology. Refer to General Conditions in the permit for signatory requirements.
