Minor Modification: Minor Modification of Coverage means a change of operation at a facility that does not substantially change the volume or nature of pollutants in the wastewater or effluent. Minor modifications include administrative changes to permit coverage and the addition/modification of groundwater monitoring points. The public notice or State Environmental Policy Act requirements do not need to be completed and no Application for Coverage is required for this modification.
