## Errata released January 16, 2020

1. Glossary, page 1120:

Revise the definition for "Outfall" as follows:

An opening with closed perimeter, usually sharp-edged, and of regular form in a plate, wall, or partition through which water may flow; generally used for the purpose of measurement or control of water.

A point source, as defined by 40 CFR 122.2, at the point where a discharge leaves the MS4 and enters a surface receiving waterbody or surface receiving waters. Outfall does not include pipes, tunnels, or other conveyances which connect segments of the same stream or other surface waters and are used to convey primarily surface waters (i.e., culverts).
