

In the matter of adopting **Infrastructure SIP Certification for the 2010 Sulfur Dioxide and 2015 Ozone National Ambient Air Quality Standard Code** in the Washington State Implementation Plan

SIP ADOPTION ORDER

The Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) offered the public an opportunity to request a hearing and comment on the draft **Infrastructure SIP Certification for the 2020 Sulfur Dioxide and 2015 Ozone National Ambient Air Quality Standard (NAAQS)**. We did not receive a request to hold a public hearing. We accepted comments from July 16, 2019 through August 30, 2019. The SIP Certification details Washington's capacity to implement, enforce, and maintain the 2010 Sulfur Dioxide and 2015 Ozone NAAQS, and will revise the Washington State Implementation Plan.

Ecology met all state and federal procedural requirements for public outreach by taking the following actions:

- Published a legal notice in one newspaper on July 16, 2019. This allowed Ecology to meet the requirement for 31 days of advance notice to request a hearing.
- Announced the public comment period and public hearing date on our online public involvement calendar.
- Published notice on our website.
- Provided an opportunity for the public to request a hearing by August 26, 2019. We did not receive a request for a hearing, so we did not hold one, as allowed by 40 CFR Section 51.102.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the referenced document, constituting the revision, is approved and adopted by the Department of Ecology as part of the Washington State Implementation Plan. All provisions of the Washington State Implementation Plan inconsistent with the attached documents are superseded.
