In the matter of adopting a State
Implementation Plan (SIP) Revision to
include the Revised Puget Sound Clean Air
Agency Regulation I Rule in the Washington
State Implementation Plan.

SIP ADOPTION ORDER

In this SIP revision, the Puget Sound Clean Air Agency (PSCAA) requests that the Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) submit to the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) changes to PSCAA's air quality regulations (Regulation I). These changes will update PSCAA's portion of the SIP and this SIP submittal will make these portions of the Regulation I federally enforceable.

Ecology offered the public an opportunity to request a hearing and comment on the draft State Implementation Plan (SIP) Revision to include the Revised Puget Sound Clean Air Agency Regulation I Rule in the Washington State Implementation Plan. We did not receive a request to hold a public hearing. We accepted comments from October 21, 2019, through December 6, 2019.

Ecology met all state and federal procedural requirements for public outreach by taking the following actions:

- Published a legal notice in one newspaper on October 21, 2019. This allowed Ecology to meet the requirement for 30 days of advance notice to request a hearing.
- Announced the public comment period and public hearing date on our online public involvement calendar.
- Published notice on our website.
- Provided an opportunity for the public to request a hearing by November 21, 2019. We did not receive a request for a hearing, so we did not hold one, as allowed by 40 CFR 51.102.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the referenced documents, constituting the revision, are approved and adopted by the Department of Ecology as part of the Washington State Implementation Plan. All provisions of the Washington State Implementation Plan inconsistent with the attached documents are superseded.
